



The community web site www.CompassionandSupport.org has been recently congratulated on winning a World Wide Web Health Award under the class, "Patient Education Information" with the category being "Web Site". This class and category is based on a web site that provides information that helps consumers cope with a chronic health condition or disease.

Entries in the Spring/Summer 2008 World Wide Web Health Awards Program were evaluated by a distinguished panel of [judges](#). Using a rating scale of 1 to 100, each judge evaluated entries for content, creativity, and an overall [assessment](#). (Entries for the [Special Awards](#) — Best Graphic Design; Best Site Navigation, Most Innovative, etc. received one overall score.) The scores were then totaled and averaged. Gold, Silver, Bronze, and Merit certificates were awarded on the basis of these averaged scores.
