National Healthcare Decisions Day 2010 Report Card

In three years, National Healthcare Decisions Day has enjoyed:

- Participation by at least 90 national organizations
- Participation by at least 900 state/local organizations
- Participation at US military at bases throughout the world
- 34 states with dedicated state liaisons

Survey results from less than half of participating organizations indicated:

- Over 1 million facility/organization staff members received NHDD/advance directive information or training
- At least 500,000 members of the general public participated in NHDD events and/or were known to have received advance directive information
- Over 14,000 advance directives were completed on the three NHDDs alone

In 2008 (NHDD's inaugural year):

- NHDD was formally recognized by both houses of Congress (S.Con.Res.73 & H.Con.Res.323)

Each year:

- NHDD has been formally recognized by several individual states and localities.
- There has been a variety of coverage in newspapers, TV, radio, and the internet
