Proposed Workgroup Goals – Revised June 6, 2010

1) Communication and Education Workgroup

- a. Develop a consistent message and implement a statewide communication work plan for MOLST, including working with the media
- b. Review current approaches to communication and education and revise current standardized approach to communication and education relating to:
 - i. Professional education
 - ii. System implementation
 - iii. Community education
- c. Identify and apply best practices in communicating and educating on:
 - i. DOH-5033 MOLST form and MOLST Instructions and Legal Requirement Checklists that comply with FHCDA
- d. Review current training tools and educational resources, including measurable outcomes
 - i. Review and suggest revisions to existing MOLST collateral materials, including MOLST videos
 - ii. Review and suggest revisions to existing MOLST pages in Patient/Family and Professional sections and MOLST Training Center
- e. Propose and develop additional needed material or tools to post on CompassionAndSupport.org through active links.
- f. Ensure consistent messaging on all print materials and CompassionAndSupport.org
- g. Develop and implement sustainable statewide education work plan for professional education, system implementation and community education
- h. Provide updates during monthly Statewide Community Implementation Team Meetings

2) EMS Workgroup

- a. Review and revise as needed the current standardized approach to communication and education for EMS providers
- b. Revise and update the EMS Web page on CompassionAndSupport.org
- c. Review and revise the MOLST Comprehension Review video
- d. Propose and develop additional needed material or tools to post on CompassionAndSupport.org
- e. Provide updates during monthly Statewide Community Implementation Team Meetings.

3) Consultation Workgroup

- a. Review and revise current advance care planning policies and procedures (including advance directive and MOLST orders) to ensure effective integration of procedures and decision-making standards set forth in FHCDA to support NYSDOH implementation of the FHCDA and revision of the MOLST.
- b. Share a template that can be used in hospitals, nursing homes and the community setting.
